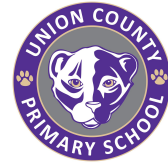




UNION COUNTY PRIMARY 2019-2020 School-Family Compact



A School-Family Compact is an agreement that parents, students, and teachers develop together. All stakeholders have an opportunity to participate in development with one or all of the following: Title 1 Spring review meeting, Title 1 Fall and Spring surveys. This compact outlines how the school staff, parents, and students will share responsibility and work together to improve student academic achievement.

Union County School District goals for the 2019-2020 school year include:

- Increase student mastery of standards by increasing the percentage of students scoring a “3” or “4” on Milestones assessments
- All schools will receive 4 stars on the GA Climate Star Rating.
- Improve the percentage of evidence-based staff development access for each academic department.
- Increase the percentage of stakeholders who feel connected with the school through varied communications methods.

Union County Primary School goals for 1st Grade for the 2019-2020 school year include:

- Students will improve RIT score, as measured through MAPS by Spring 2020.
- Students will improve accuracy on addition and subtraction facts through 10 by Spring 2020.
- Improve student writing skills as measured by a grade level rubric.
- Increase family communication and provide an environment where families are included in the learning process.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Assess and send home students’ reading performance at least three times per year, with suggestions for ways to help at home. ● Provide practice and monitor student progress in basic math skills. Assess and send home students math performance, at least three times per year, with suggestions for ways to help at home. ● Teachers will assess student writing skills through a writing rubric, provide students with multiple opportunities to write, share exemplary works of writing and discuss what makes it exemplary, and send home student writing samples with suggestions for ways to help at home. ● Send home agendas daily to help parents understand what students are learning and doing in class. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Schedule time for reading practice each day and follow suggestions to help their children. ● Provide time for math practice each day and follow suggestions to help their children. ● Encourage written expression, especially sounding out words and learning to spell age appropriate sight words. ● Communicate with teachers and students regarding progress by attending conferences, discussing work brought home in the communication folders, and attending family-school events when possible. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Read daily – during and after school ● Practice math facts during and after school. ● Follow the suggestions provided by teachers to help improve written expression, academic, and social growth. ● Bring home communication folder and agendas with classwork, newsletters, notices about family events, etc., and share it with parents.
